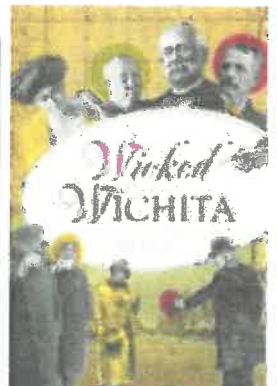

Joe Stumpe has been a professional writer for 30 years, authoring articles for The New York Times, Agence France-Presse, Wichita Eagle, Arkansas Democrat-Gazette, Splurge magazine and many advertising clients. From 2000 to 2009 he was food editor of The Wichita Eagle. He continues to be active in the city's food scene through his catering operation and cooking demonstrations. As a musician, Stumpe performs frequently in the Wichita area and has recorded three CDs of original songs. He is currently the editor of "Active Aging"

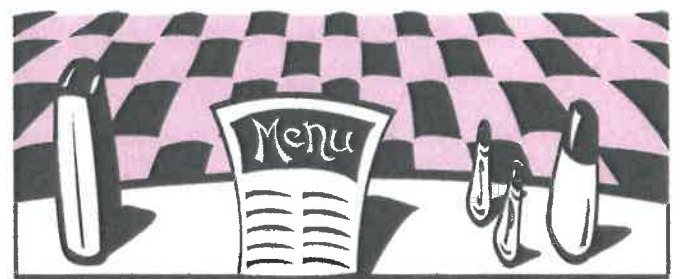

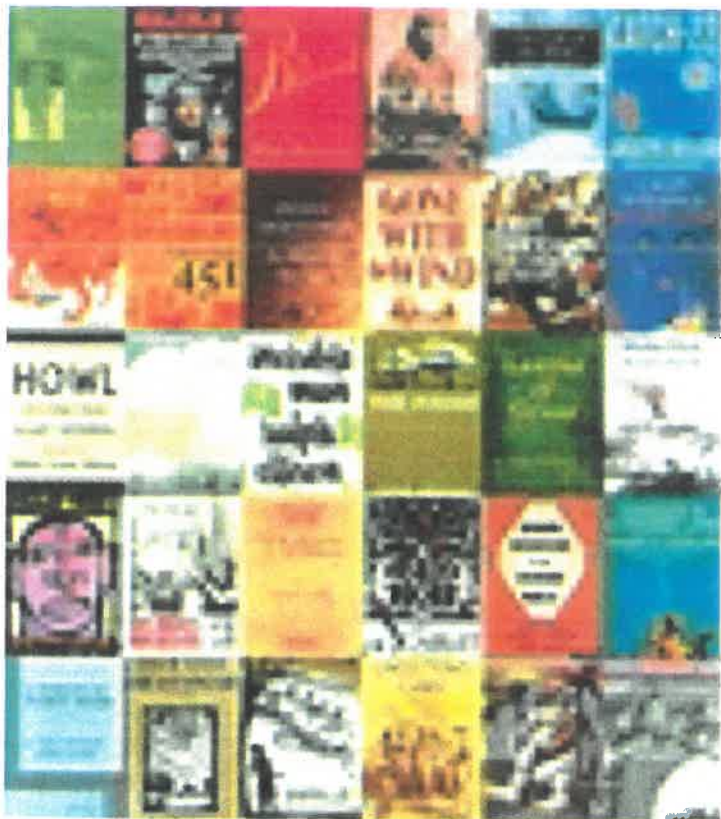

BANNED BOOKS WEEK

September 22-28

It's that time again – Banned Books Week – to consider the hundreds of books, some of them classics, that have been banned across the country at one time or another.

Libraries and bookstores are promoting the titles that have been yanked from reading lists, schools and library shelves because someone – typically a parent, often complaining about sexually explicit material, offensive language, violence or homosexuality – found them problematic. “The Diary of Anne Frank,” “The Great Gatsby,” “To Kill a Mockingbird” and “Catcher in the Rye” have all been challenged for various reasons. Three years ago, the children’s book “Captain Underpants” beat out “Fifty Shades of Grey” for most banned honors.

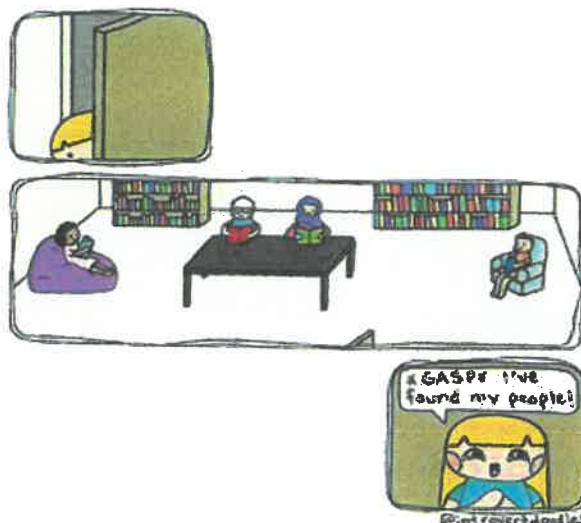
Of course, people will be murdered. Members of the audience will be asked to vote for the guilty party. Those with the right answer will win a brand new Best Seller.
